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REWARDS

Reward Scheme	Achievement Criteria and Rewards
 <p>Principal's Learner of the week</p>	<p>Staff will nominate students who have shown excellent contribution and fantastic work ethic in lessons. One nominated student will then be picked by our principal to be "Principal's Learner of the Week".</p>
 <p>Terrific Tuesdays & Fabulous Fridays</p>	<p>Heads of Year will identify a chosen learner of the week. Winners will receive a bag of of Haribo, certificate and photo with their head of year.</p> <p>To achieve this reward Heads of Year will be analysing positive points and students work ethic in lessons.</p>
 <p>Outstanding Lesson Contribution</p>	<p>When students show great work ethic in lessons and outstanding contribution, they will be rewarded with a reward point and a Caister Coin.</p> <p>Coins will be added to the year group collection point once a week, ready for a chance to win an end of half term, whole year group reward.</p> <p>Every Wednesday there will also be lucky dip coins, to win an instant prize.</p>
 <p>Subject Excellence Weekly Reward</p>	<p>Each week, subjects will be nominating a student from every year group who has shown excellence within that subject. Students will receive a personalised postcard explaining why they have achieved such an amazing reward.</p>

Subject Excellence Half Term Award

Half termly, two students per year group will be awarded a subject excellence pin. Students are nominated by their teachers based on their hard work in lessons across the half term.



SEAL Reading

Half termly 'SEAL' readers will be nominated from each KS3 year group to receive badges and certificates. This will be awarded to students who have read the most books that half term/read the most challenging texts. Led by the form tutor, there will also be an annual award for top reader in each KS3 year group, with a certificate and prize.

SEAL reading badges will also be given to students who graduate from a reading intervention, to recognise the dedication made to improve their reading age.

There will also be a reward trip at the end of the year, available to all students who have made significant progress or contribution to school literacy, including student librarians and SEAL readers.



Sparx Mathematics

Each half term mathematics nominates students based on their engagement with Sparx, students can achieve a variety of badges and certificates based on their efforts.

Annually the top students who receive "experience points" will receive a direct award given by Sparx.

Weekly, top students who have receive the most "experience points" will be "Sparx student of the week" receiving a certificate and reward points.

Celebrating Academic Performance

We want to celebrate students who demonstrate outstanding achievement. Students with the highest grades after each assessment point will receive a certificate, a postcard home, and recognition in assembly. Students who meet or exceed their target grades will also receive a certificate and postcard home. Finally, subjects will provide rewards to any student who demonstrates outstanding attitude in the reteach lesson after each assessment.

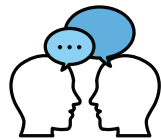

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 <p>Freddo Friday</p>	<p>If a student attends every day, they will receive a weekly Freddo bar on a Friday in form time for 100% attendance for the week</p>
	<p>At various points throughout the year, we will hold out 100%. If students attend 100%, or a certain number of days within the allocated month, they will be rewarded for their attendance.</p>
	<p>At the end of each half term, student will receive a post card for daily signatures in the final week. If they attend every day in the final week of term, they will be rewarded upon their return after the holidays.</p>
 <p>Trust League Competitions</p>	<p>We will also enter trust league competitions where we will battle against other schools in the trust for outstanding attendance. Students will be rewarded with treats and events if Caister Academy rise to the top.</p>
